




ABOUT US

The Association Mensajeros de la Paz (Messengers of Peace) was founded in 1962 by Father Ángel García Rodríguez. It is a non-governmental organization, declared of public utility, that works at a national and international level and has been awarded the Prince of Asturias Award for Concord, among other distinctions.

Mensajeros works in over 50 countries, promoting the human and social development of society's most underprivileged populations and adapting to all the different social realities.

In Spain Assistance to people in situations of vulnerability

CHILDHOOD

Socio-educational family and childhood center:

In Madrid, we accompany children, from their first days of life up to the age of 16, that, along with their families, find themselves in a position of social vulnerability.

We promote equal opportunities by facilitating the socio-educational development and social inclusion process.

During 2020, this project assisted 40 children daily. Furthermore, we provided them with tablets to reduce the digital divide.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this project is temporally closed. This project mainly contributes to the following SDGs











VICTIMS OF GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

Mensajeros runs two emergency centers for women victims of gender-based violence and their children. We seek to provide urgent protection, psychological and social attention to contribute to their empowerment and social reintegration.

During 2020, 25 people were assisted daily in both center.

This project mainly contributes to the following SDGs:















ELDERLY PEOPLE

In 2020, we assisted the elderly more than ever through the following projects and campaigns:

- Residences and Senior Centers.
- Golden Telephone Program
- Special Campaigns due to the Pandemic



Residences and Senior Centers:

Our residential model is conceived as a socio-sanitary service aimed at the elderly with different degrees of self-sufficiency. We focus on their basic needs, either therapeutic or social, and encourage their autonomy to ensure they can continue being the masters of their lives.

In 2020, we strengthened our cares to protect the health of the elder people living in the different residences and senior centers.



Mensajeros de la Paz supervises, through the different offices, 104 residencies for elderly people in Spain. From Madrid, we run the following residences:



Residence and Municipal Senior Center in Campo Real Dolores Soria Residence and Senior Center in Pinto Getafe Alzheimer Residence in Getafe Villaverde Alzheimer Residence, Senior Center and Respite Center in Madrid Montserrat Caballé Residence and Senior Center in Barajas, Madrid Don Bosco Residence in Barajas Isla Taray Residence in Morata in Tajuña, Madrid Parque Coimbra Residence and Senior Center in Móstoles, Madrid Marqués de Santillana Residence in Buitrago de Lozoya, Madrid Edad Dorada Senior Center in Madrid Mensajeros de la Paz Residential Complex in La Bañeza, León Villa de Alija Residence in Alija del Infantado, León San Pedro de Alcántara Residence in Arenas de San Pedro, Ávila La Piedad Residence in Palencia Virgen del Carbayu Residence in Ciaño, Asturias El Salvador Residence in Lagartera, Toledo San Prudencio Assisted Housing in Nájera, La Rioja

In the residencies, we take care of over 100 elderly people in situation of social emergency.

Most of them are referred from Madrid's Social Services Organization SAMUR SOCIAL.



Golden Telephone Program:

Through active listening, we accompany the people calling in a situation of unwanted loneliness and isolation.

Throughout 2020, we received 12,075 calls and, thanks to the help of 85 volunteers, we were able to attend 53 users daily. Furthermore, we have signed an agreement with La Barandilla Association to refer to them the calls of those people in need of counselling for preventing suicide.

Special Campaigns due to the Pandemic

- We have assisted over 5,000 elderly people by buying and conducting more than 4,000 detection tests.
- We have distributed thousands of hygiene items, 9 ozone generators and 110 disinfectant spray machines suitable for sanitizing large areas.
- We have implemented mental health helplines.
- We have distributed 600 tablets to the 104 residencies under the care of Mensajeros de la Paz in order to assure the elderly's communication with their families.



The assistance to the elderly projects contribute to the following SDGs:











We have a residence to accommodate the family of patients hospitalized in the National Hospital for Paraplegics of Toledo.

We provide them with a housing solution at a social cost and we carry out a psycho-social and socio-cultural accompaniment process.

Throughout 2020, this residence assisted 12 people daily.

PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

We collaborate with the Prominfas Foundation to promote the rights of people with disabilities.



In 2020, we accompanied more than 30 people.

ASSISTANCE TO PEOPLE AT RISK OF SOCIAL EXCLUSION

CHURCH AND SOCIAL CENTER OF SAN ANTÓN


Located in Madrid, this project began in 2015 and, despite the difficult time during the Pandemic, it has maintained its pastoral and social spirit. Furthermore, it ensures the participant's right to food. Its main courses of action are the following:

1- Pastoral activities:

We have carried out prays and daily streaming masses, along with collaborative and sensitization campaigns with the neighbors and faithful church members.

2- Social intervention:

Daily, we coordinate our activities with the local social services to help people in need of shelter to sleep, as well as providing hairdressing services ("Pelo Bus") and showers.

3- Activities to ensure the right to food:

SAN ANTÓN'S BREAKFASTS.

With the volunteers' help, we bring breakfasts every day to over 150 people who find themselves in a situation of homelessness and loneliness. In 2020, this project had to be adapted to the new sanitary situation derived from the Pandemic, and breakfasts were given as a takeaway option alongside with a hot cup of coffee.



SAN ANTÓN'S FOOD PANTRY

This project was launched in 2020 as a way of reinforcing our commitment with the families at risk of poverty due to the COVID-19 crisis.

We handed solidarity emergency food baskets and provided accompaniment. Moreover, we worked along with other organizations to find the best solution for each case.



We supported and co-financed Santa Anna's Church in Barcelona, open 24 hours to assist homeless and people at risk of social exclusion.

We also run a voluntary campaign with neighbors from the Justicia quarter to help the elderly people from the area go shopping and to assist them with their needs.

In 2020, we assisted over 450 people daily through the three courses of action.

This project mainly contributes to the following SDGs:







ROBIN HOOD

This solidarity restaurant has been operating since 2016 with the main goal of dignifying peoples' right to food. With the support of volunteers, we offer daily dinners in a relaxed friendly atmosphere. Due to the Pandemic, meals were offered as take-away.





In 2020, we provided over 50 people with dinner every day.

This project mainly contributes to the following SDGs:







OPPORTUNITY HOMES

This is a housing service aimed at people in socio-residential exclusion or living in the street. It offers a personalized comprehensive intervention to improve their situation.

Currently, in Madrid, we have 12 homes for different profiles:


- Home destined to men.
- Home destined to women.
- Home destined to autonomous elderly people.
- Home with a capacity for three families destined to Single-Parent Families.
- 3 homes for families at risk of social exclusion.
- 5 homes named "Housing First", aimed at people that used to live in the street.







In 2020, we assisted more than 80 people daily. Furthermore, we have strengthened the psychological support and provided our homes with over 100 tablets to reinforce distance education.













International Projects

We work in over 50 countries through our own offices and partner organizations, with the aim of contributing to the improvement of people's standard of living, regardless of their location.

In 2020, we have reinforced the cooperation with different countries around the world in order to fight the sanitary crisis caused by Covid-19. The main countries in which we have cooperated are:

THEAMERICAS

ARGENTINA

We supported our local office to face the sanitary crisis and strengthened the care of children, young and elderly people through centers, homes, residencies as well as artistic and educative projects.



Over 1,000 people benefited from this help.

In Argentina, we mainly contribute to the following SDGs:











GUATAMELA

We rendered emergency relief through Bomberos Unidos Sin Fronteras (United Firefighters Without Borders) to deal with the damage caused by hurricanes Eta and Iota.



Hundreds of people were assisted thanks to this campaign.

HONDURAS

We have helped our local office with their Guarataro Socio-educational Community by guaranteeing food and promoting health, education and hygiene to the participants. Moreover, we have rendered emergency aid to hundreds of families, providing food and warm clothing, with the aim of dealing with the damage caused by the hurricanes.

In 2020, we assisted over 500 children and their families.

In Honduras, we mainly contribute to the following SDGs:













MEXICO

We have rendered food aid to hundreds of people in our 24-hr church. What is more, we continued supporting the children's homes, a senior center and a retirement home for sex worker women.

PARAGUAY

In Asunción, we continued helping a residence for elderly people with no resources with their daily and maintenance needs. Besides, we have supported schoolbooks' translations to promote the education of the indigenous community.



Over 6,700 children and families participated in our projects in Paraguay.

UNITED STATES

We collaborated with Fundación Hermanos de la Calle (Brothers of the Street Foundation) to create care homes for people living in the streets of Miami. Furthermore, we are helping a soup kitchen in New York through Saint Rita's Church in Bronx.

Throughout 2020, we attended over 400 people.

URUGUAY

We continued supporting our office through two Early Childhood Centers, providing a comprehensive assistance to the children and their families in Montevideo.



In 2020, we assisted 250 children and their families.

VENEZUELA

We organized the Pro Venezuela campaign to send medicine through Caritas.

We helped over 50 people with this campaign.

This campaign mainly contributed to the following SDGs:







BURUNDI

Through Misioneros de África Padres Blancos (White Fathers Missionaries of Africa), we carried a rainwater harvesting project to facilitate access to irrigation water to the community. In this way, we encouraged the development and cooperation among the local people.

This project assisted hundreds of people.












CAMEROON

Alongside the NGO Mirando por África (Looking after Africa), we collaborated on funding for housing and occupational therapy aimed at children with functional diversity in Douala.



Thanks to this project, we have helped over 25 people.









ETHIOPIA

In the city of Gondar, we collaborated with the NGO AYME to continue supporting the Maternity Center, and to help a shelter for women with HIV. Furthermore, we cooperated rehabilitating the University Hospital's Orphan Residence in the city, as well as obtaining the funding for their higher education.

We awarded scholarships to encourage the educational process of children that had participated in our project "Casa de la Paz" (House of Peace).




TOTAL INCOMES IN 2020: 5.476.712 €




TOTAL EXPENSES IN 2020: 5.173.905 €




The assistance to people in situation of social exclusion includes the following projects: Church and Social Center of San Antón, Robin Hood Restaurant and Opportunity Homes.
