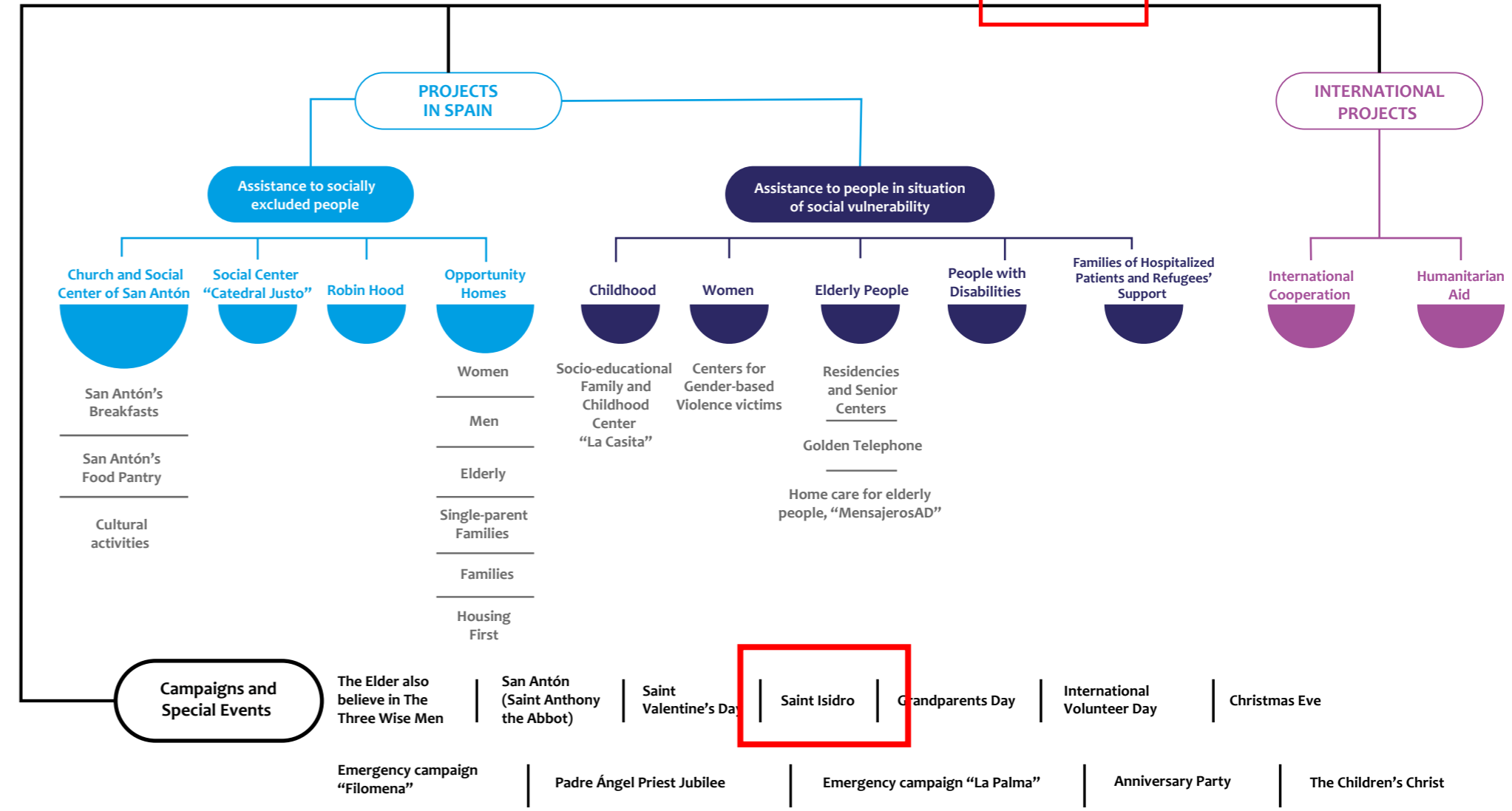

PROJECTS AND CAMPAIGNS

SPAIN



ASSISTANCE TO SOCIALLY EXCLUDED PEOPLE

CHURCH AND SOCIAL CENTER OF SAN ANTÓN

Located in Madrid, this project was born in 2015 and, despite the pandemic, it has maintained its pastoral, social and cultural spirit. Furthermore, it guarantees the right to food for the people who attend. Its main lines of action are:

1. Pastoral activities

We have continued to carry out prayers and the daily mass by streaming and we have resumed the face-to-face activities

2. Social intervention

We offer social services on a daily basis for homeless or at-social-risk people.



COVID 19 VACCINATION

In coordination with Social Emergency Services and the sanitary centers of Madrid, a total of 223 people in vulnerable situation, with difficulties of access to vaccination and Public Health Care, have been vaccinated. All of them are participants of different projects from San Anton Church (Robin Hood, Pantry, Breakfasts and Opportunity Homes).



3. Cultural activities

During 2021, San Antón Church offered more than 100 cultural activities, including choirs, concerts and talks.

San Antón Talks

We have brought together more than 30 personalities from different sectors of our society, including mayors, current and former ministers, renowned journalists as well as writers, elite sportsmen and women, and many others.

All of them have been invited to speak live with our broadcaster, Federico Acaso, over a variety of themes: scientific divulgation, sports, social aspects, politics and journalism, art and religion, etc.

All the talks have been broadcast live on our YouTube channel, with audiences well exceeding 5000 viewers for some talks, and are currently still on demand for those who wish to view them. Among our guests are Maria Dueñas, Iñaki Gabilondo, Carmen Calvo and Jose Luis Martinez Almeida.



4. Activities to guarantee the right to food

San Antón's Breakfasts

With the volunteers' help, we bring breakfasts every day to over 150 people who find themselves in a situation of homelessness and loneliness. In 2021, due to the sanitary situation we kept on offering breakfasts as a takeaway option alongside with a hot cup of coffee, in two different locations in the center of Madrid.

San Antón's Food Pantry

This project began in 2020 to reinforce our compromise with families in poverty risk aggravated by the pandemic crisis. We deliver solidarity emergency food baskets and provide accompaniment, seeking to find the most appropriate solution in each case, though networking with other entities.

The beneficiaries are people excluded from the system who would not have access to any resources without this project.

Robin Hood Solidary Restaurant

This is a pioneer project which was created in 2016 to dignify the right to food. It offers dinners in a family, friendly and relaxed atmosphere, sharing a moment of listening and closeness every day of the year. With the support of a team of volunteers as waiters, the beneficiaries are able to socialize around the table, tablecloth and food at this restaurant.

Besides, I have also been able to interact with volunteers and users and meet some great people with whom I have learned a lot”.

In order to contribute to SDG 2, we have conducted an impact verification of our program “Access to adequate food for an active, healthy and dignified life for people at risk of social exclusion”, which includes all food projects for people at social risk in Madrid. We thus seek to measure our impact more efficiently in order to offer more guarantees and confidence to our donors, collaborators, beneficiaries and society in general.

Opportunity Homes

This project guarantees access to housing and coverage of basic needs, as well as a work plan for people in social and residential exclusion and in street situations. During 2021 in Madrid, we have had 13 homes for different profiles:

- Home destined to men
- Home destined to women
- Home destined to autonomous elderly people
- Home with a capacity for three families destined to Single-Parent Families
- Emergency home for short-term stays
- 3 homes for families at risk of social exclusion
- 5 homes named "Housing First", aimed at people that used to live in the street

SOCIAL CENTRE JUSTO CATHEDRAL

This building, located in Mejorada del Campo, Madrid, has been built for over 60 years, by a single man, Justo Gallego, with no architectural training or construction experience, in honor of the Virgin Mary. It is a pioneering example of sustainability as he has used a lot of waste and recycled materials. Praised by experts and architects, the MOMA museum in New York dedicated an exhibition to him in 2006.

Before passing away, Justo Gallego donated the cathedral to Mensajeros de la Paz, to finish his work so it becomes a place of peace and a hosting place for praying; a place to welcome all people, believers and non-believers, those who need help, the forgotten, the lonely; to be a meeting place for different religions, a small field hospital, a house of solidarity to share.



We have worked with the **SANTA ANA CHURCH** in Barcelona, which opens 24h daily to attend to people in homelessness and at social exclusion risk.

Social Projects in Valencia

We have continued to support the various social projects of our Mensajeros de la Paz headquarters in Valencia to respond to the various growing social demands that we see in the city and surrounding areas.

We provide different services to people in situations of social vulnerability, offering accompaniment so that they can see their basic needs are covered.

The main activities that we have developed during 2021 are:

VALENCIA

***Delivery of take-away food:** Soup kitchen (due to the pandemic, it became take-away). Prepared food for people with no means to cook. 700 menus per week. 33600 menus delivered during the year.

***Solidarity wardrobe:** We deliver new or in excellent condition clothes to those who cannot afford to buy them. Over 200 families benefited.

***Pantry:** 140 people monthly receive non-perishable food.

***Hygienic bus:** The goal of this bus is to offer visibility, affection and dignity to those without a home. We offer 30 showers and haircuts weekly.

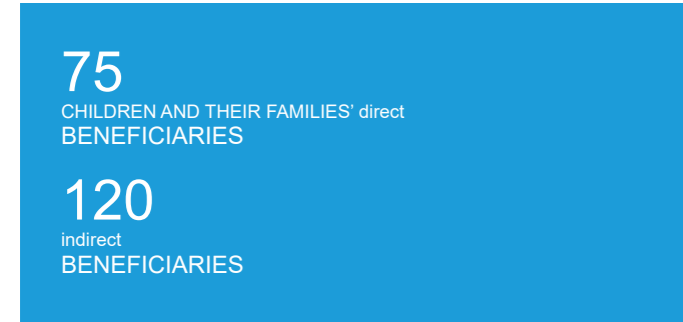


Socio Educative center for family and childhood: "The Little House of Mensajeros"

We have reopened in October after the pandemic!

This is a center that helps families in vulnerable situations to reconcile family and work life. We accompany children while their primary caregivers are unable to be with them. Furthermore, we offer comprehensive support to families who need it in collaboration with other projects, within our organization or in collaboration with others like the Social Services of the Madrid City Council.

By guaranteeing the well-being of children, we aim to favor the labor insertion of families, thus promoting family autonomy and promotion.



Mensajeros runs two emergency centers, in Madrid and Alicante, where we offer immediate and safe housing and comprehensive specialized assistance for women victims of gender-based violence and their children (when there are). We guarantee disposal, accessibility and quality.

Home Care for elderly people: Mensajerosad

Residencies and Day Care Centers

Our residential model is conceived as a socio-sanitary service aimed at the elderly with different degrees of self-sufficiency. We assist them on their basic, therapeutic and relational needs, and encourage their autonomy to ensure they can continue being the masters of their lives.

In our residencies we have attended throughout 2021 more than 2800 elderly people, 100 of them in a situation of social emergency. Most of them are referred from Madrid’s Social Services Organization SAMUR SOCIAL.

Golden Telephone Program

Through active listening, we accompany the people calling in a situation of unwanted loneliness and isolation. This year, due to the pandemic, the service continued to provide uninterrupted service to users, either by answering calls in person at headquarters or remotely from the volunteers’ homes.

In 2021, 22,064 calls were received, with an average of 91 calls per day, thanks to **93 volunteers**. In addition, we have signed a reciprocity agreement with the Anar Foundation for mutual referrals.

Mensajerosad

In 2021 we have created a new service aimed at our elderly and dependent population: Mensajerosad (<https://mensajerosad.com>). It is a **home assistance program**, when elderly people or their relatives decide to promote care from their own home.

After a comprehensive assessment of health, social, cognitive, functional or psychological aspects, the main problems detected are identified, thus allowing a complete personalization of the assistance. The services provided can be very diverse: health care, domestic support, companionship, support in personal care, domestic repairs, etc. with the aim of preserving autonomy within the home, but under the supervision of experienced persons.



FAMILIES OF HOSPITALIZED PATIENTS

During 2021 we continued managing a residence to accommodate the family of patients hospitalized in the National Hospital for Paraplegics of Toledo.

We provided them with a housing solution at a social cost and we carried out a psycho-social and socio-cultural accompaniment process.

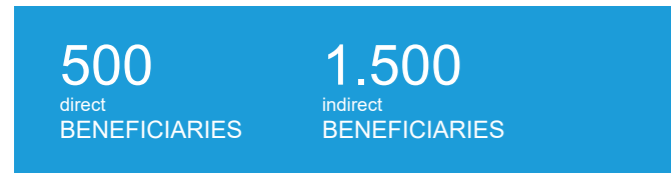
ARGENTINA

We have collaborated in various projects, for example, rebuilding part of Saint Joseph's Home, where 50 elderly people live and which was destroyed after a tree fell.

HONDURAS

We helped our local office with the Guarataro Socio-Educational Community by supporting the provision of food, health, education and hygiene to the participants. This center follows the Montessori method, based on the respect to children and the environment. Moreover, we have provided emergency aid to hundreds of families, supplying food and warm clothing, with the aim of dealing with the damage caused by the hurricanes. We also continued with the meals service through the Robin Hood Restaurant.

Until April 2021 we maintained our regular support to the Chiesa delle Santissime Stimate di San Francesco (Holy Stigmata of St. Francis' Church), a 24h-church, providing breakfast and counseling for people living in the street. After this Church had to close due to the pandemic, we continued this collaboration in the Church Santa Lucia of Gonfalone, where between 70-100 breakfasts are served every Wednesday and about 120 meals every Sunday.

Between them, 4560 breakfasts and 5760 meals were distributed in 2021. We have received many donations of coffee and pastries, which have allowed us to accompany the breakfasts with 2-3 pieces of organic fruit for each person.

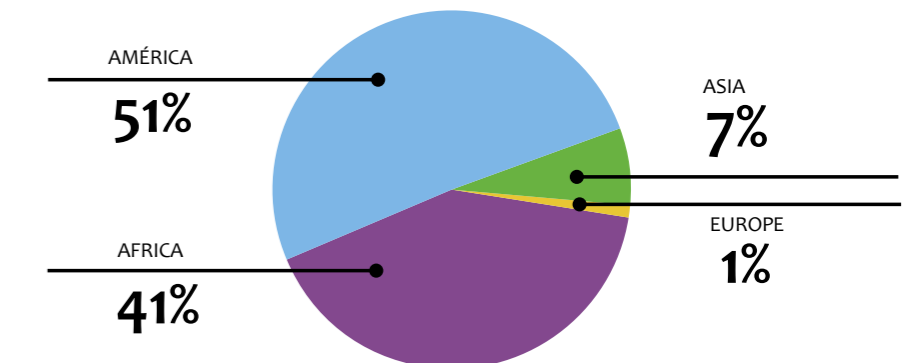
Destination of funds: **PROJECTS IN SPAIN**
