Dear friends,

This 2022, which we have just left behind, has been a particularly special year for the entire Mensajeros de la Paz family. We have made great efforts to continue our work by helping those in need while also finding time to celebrate the **60th anniversary of the Mensajeros de la Paz Association**.

Sixty years during which over 61,300 children and young people have been attended at our opportunity homes and youth centers; over 30,000 elderly people have been cared for in nursing homes and day centers; over 1,022,000 breakfasts have been delivered to homeless people at the Church of San Antón; and over 7,192,139 calls have been answered on the Golden Telephone. This has been possible thanks to more than 6,000 volunteers who have participated in our projects, both in Spain and the various countries where we are established. Furthermore, we also have to thank more than 4,500 workers, 90% of which are women.

In 2022 Mensajeros de la Paz continued to develop its projects in the 76 countries where we collaborate with other organizations, as well as with our own offices, to safeguard the fundamental rights of children, young people, families, and the elderly who need our support. Moreover, **this year we have focused**, **especially, on helping the Ukranian people and many others that were forced to leave their homes due to the war**.

At Mensajeros de la Paz, we continue to align our projects with the **17 SDGs** (Sustainable Development Goals) proposed to protect the planet, end poverty, ensure gender equality, etc.

Undoubtedly, 2022 represents a year of sacrifice, work, and dedication that would not have been possible without the support of all the people who make up the great Mensajeros de la Paz family: collaborating companies and institutions, volunteers, donors, friends, and people who work tirelessly with us to carry out all our social projects, which you can see throughout this report.

We hope that this year 2023, which is already making its way into our lives, finds us full of energy and united to face new challenges. Together we are much stronger, and we can build a better world that is within our reach.



Residencies and Day Care Centers:

Our residential model is conceived as a socio-sanitary service aimed at the elderly with different degrees of self-sufficiency.

We assist them with their basic, therapeutic and relational needs, and encourage their autonomy to ensure they can continue being the masters of their lives.

In 2022, more than **100** elderly people in a situation of social emergency have been cared for in our residences. Most of them are referred from Madrid's Social Services **Organization SAMUR SOCIAL and Ukrainian** refugees.



CHURCH AND SOCIAL CENTER OF SAN ANTÓN

Located in Madrid, this 24-hour church could open its doors again to its fullest. Its main lines of action are

1-Pastoral activities:

We have continued to carry out prayers and the daily mass (streaming and face-to-face). Moreover, we have resumed face-to-face activities.

2-Social intervention:

We offer social services on a daily basis for homeless or at-social-risk people.

3-Cultural activities:

During 2022, San Antón Church offered more than 100 cultural activities, including choirs, concerts and talks, among others.

Furthermore, we have continued supporting Santa Anna Church (Barcelona), a 24-hour church that helps homeless and at-social-risk people





4-. Activities to guarantee the right to food:

San Antón's Breakfasts

Daily, and thanks to the support of volunteers, we bring breakfast to people who find themselves in a situation of homelessness and loneliness.

San Antón's Food Pantry

Since 2020, we hand in solidarity emergency food baskets and provide accompaniment to families at poverty risk. We seek to find the best solution for each case.

Number of baskets delivered: 538.

One day I was passing by San Antón and decided to come in. I was praying when I started to cry... I felt so much anguish. A volunteer sat next to me and listened to me carefully, without judging, validated my emotions, told me about Robin Hood and gave me food. His words got me thinking and I left much calmer than when I arrived.

Currently, after several months, I still attend Robin Hood, but I have also begun to help at the Solidarity Pantry as a volunteer. Meeting Mensajeros de la Paz prevented my vulnerable situation from worsening. Since I migrated to Spain, I have gone through different situations, some more adverse than others. The truth is that every time a need arose in me, I turned to Mensajeros and I ALWAYS got help and attention.

During this time, I have always noticed the same values: respect, service, implicit in every gesture and concrete in every action, and freedom: my decision was always respected. For this reason, today I want to thank enormously the great family of Mensajeros de la Paz. **>>**








ALAMIN PROJECT, GUADALAJARA



UKRAINE

HUMANITARIAN AID CAMPAIGN FOR UKRAINE

Since the beginning of the war, our actions have been oriented to support people inside Ukraine, those on the frontiers and the ones that arrived in Spain. Our actions were adapted according to the individual situations and were coordinated with other NGOs and official institutions. Furthermore, humanitarian aid and transfer of people also took place in Moldavia, Romania, and Poland.

We helped our local office with the Guarataro Socio-Educational Community by supporting the provision of food, health, education and hygiene to the participants. Moreover, we continued supporting the meals served through the Robin Hood Restaurant and the free Gynecologist for women in vulnerable situations.

Additionally, in the month of November, we visited the country to meet with ambassadors and personalities, and to observe directly the projects being carried out there. During the trip, new collaboration agreements were also signed to expand our work in the country, and donations were made by the NGO 105 Juguetes and the Cádiz Club de Fútbol.

Once again, this year, we have collaborated with our church 24 hours, providing food assistance to hundreds of people. Furthermore, we have reinforced our commitment to children's homes, a residence for elderly people, and a residence for senior women who work as sexual workers.

This year also, we signed a new agreement with the Pondera Foundation and Gondar University Hospital to continue supporting Mulu Maternity and help improve the health of the city.

We awarded scholarships to encourage the educational process of the children that participated in our project "Casa de la Paz" (House of Peace).
