This year, especially, we have turned our attention to the people who suffered the consequences of the **earthquake in Turkey**. We have also strengthened our international cooperation in countries such as Argentina, Honduras, Ethiopia and the United States, and above all in projects in Spain.

One more year, from Mensajeros we have continued to develop our projects under the protection of the **17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)** established by the UN in order to improve the world in which we live. This year 2023, the organisation has renewed the Special Category **Consultative Status** of Mensajeros de la Paz before the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (**ECOSOC**).

Tolerance, solidarity, justice or respect are some of the values with which we feel identified since Mensajeros was founded more than 60 years ago. Values that have remained intact and that guide us in our mission and commitment to society. However, society has been evolving and with it the needs of people. For this reason, in addition to continue implementing the **Compliance model**, we have developed a new **ethical code** in order to continue working according to our values and principles.

This has been a year of sacrifices, work and effort, but also of celebrations, such as the **25th anniversary of Grandparents' Day**. All of this would not have been possible without each and every one of the people who are part of Mensajeros de la Paz: companies and collaborating institutions, volunteers, donors, friends, people who help us to develop all the social projects that are detailed in this report.

We would like to end this letter with a few words of hope for this year 2024. May it find us stronger and more united than ever so that, with the help of Ángel Silva, friend and co-founder of Mensajeros, who is watching us from heaven, we can face all the challenges that are to come. ## ASSISTANCE TO SOCIALLY EXCLUDED PEOPLE

### SAN ANTÓN CHURCH AND SOCIAL CENTER

The main areas of action of this church, located in central Madrid and open 24 hours a day, are:

#### 1-Pastoral Activities:

We continue to offer daily mass, prayers, sacraments, and other religious ceremonies, both in-person and via streaming.

#### 2-Social Intervention:

We provide daily social guidance to people experiencing homelessness or social risk, with the support of professionals in social work, law, psychology, and coaching.

**This year, we developed an employment inclusion project with LHH**, focused on the socio-labor inclusion of vulnerable individuals. We offer guidance, mentoring, training, and job placement services to those in vulnerable situations. Workshops were held on social skills, IT, active job searching, interview preparation, and customer service training, resulting in two job placements and preparing participants for future opportunities.

#### 3-Cultural Activities:

In 2023, San Antón Church hosted more than 100 cultural activities, including choirs, concerts, and talks, among others.

We also continue to support other “field hospital” churches in Jordan and Barcelona (Santa Anna Church), which remain open 24 hours to assist people experiencing homelessness and those at risk of social exclusion.

Additionally, we support Field Hospital Churches in Rome (Santa Lucia de Gonfalone) and Mexico (Parish of Santa Cruz y Nuestra Señora de la Soledad).



4- Activities to Guarantee the Right to Food:

**San Antón Breakfasts**

This year, we provided over **91,000 breakfasts** to people experiencing homelessness or severe socioeconomic exclusion, with the support of volunteers.

**Solidarity Pantry**

Since 2020, we have distributed emergency solidarity baskets and offered support to families at risk of poverty, working to find the most suitable solution for each case.

In 2023, we delivered 1,344 baskets to vulnerable families.

This year, we added fresh products to the baskets thanks to a new collaboration agreement with Mercadona.

**Solidarity Coffee with Sandwich.** Through an agreement with Enrique Tomás, we distributed 35,000 sandwiches.




**OPPORTUNITY HOMES**



BANGLADESH

We continue to assist in the healthcare sector in Bangladesh. In 2023, we supported a collaboration project between a team of specialized doctors and Xaverian missionaries. 886 people were discharged from St. Mary's Hospital in the city of Khulna.

During our intervention at the hospital, various medical activities were carried out, including general surgery consultation services for 291, as well as surgical interventions for 131 individuals in total. In terms of donations, we were able to contribute to 62.5% of the direct financial funds needed to carry out the campaign, as well as providing various dental and school materials.






**TOTAL INCOMES IN 2023: 7.789.357 €**




**Destination of funds: PROJECTS IN SPAIN**




**TOTAL EXPENSES IN 2023: 7.455.171 €**
